





Srinakharinwirot University's publishing performance: (2020-2025) by journal quartile (CiteScore)





Example for the %share of Q1 publications from Top 100 QS University : 2020-2025 by CiteScore







If you are submitting to a hybrid journal, you will be asked to choose whether you wish to publish open access - don't worry if you are unsure at this stage, because we will ask you this question again post-acceptance.
- **Step 4:** If the journal accepts your article, you receive an email containing a clickable link to the "post acceptance author journey". During this journey, we ask you to review and confirm your affiliation and funder details. This information is used by the system to determine which personalized publishing options to show you, including the option to publish under this agreement.
- **Step 5:** Confirm your publishing choices and complete the post acceptance journey.
- **Step 6:** Your institution validates your eligibility for the agreement. Please note: **The final decision on your eligibility lies with the person at your institution responsible for managing and administering this agreement.** If you have any concerns that your administrator may reject your request for APC support, please check with them before confirming that you want to publish open access.
- **Step 7:** You and your co-authors receive an email to confirm that the APC will be covered by the agreement.

What is a Read & Publish agreement?

Elsevier has partnered with academic institutions and consortia around the world to support authors who wish to publish open access: <https://www.elsevier.com/open-access/agreements>.

Under a Read and Publish agreement, the cost of publishing open access is covered. Eligible corresponding authors do not have to pay an article publishing charge or APC.

Key definitions

Definition

Submitting corresponding author

- Submitting corresponding author is the author who submits the article to Elsevier and stays in contact with Elsevier in the end-to-end journey
- This is the author who makes the publishing choice on behalf of the author group. Every article has one corresponding author.
- For the purposes of eligibility under the agreement, there can only be one corresponding author. The corresponding author is the author who submits the manuscript and other documentation to the journal and is the primary contact between the journal and the co-authors. Importantly, the corresponding author's affiliation will be used to determine eligibility for the publishing agreement.
- The affiliations of other co-authors are not relevant for agreement eligibility.
- Journals may follow requests of the team of authors and display other corresponding authors in the published article. Which corresponding authors are displayed on the published paper, however, is not relevant for agreement eligibility.

Acceptance Date

This is the date the journal accepts the article for publication

Elsevier OA Platform

Elsevier OA Platform (EOAP) is a user-friendly interface where we present the institutional administrators with the open access articles eligible for the agreement.

Administrators at the institution validate the eligibility of the author for an OA agreement

Eligibility criteria

Eligibility component	Description

SCO	Short Communication	A short report or announcement of research, usually claiming certain results. (may appear under many names, e.g. Letter Papers, Preliminary Notes, Notes, etc)
SSU	Short Survey	A short or mini Review Article, summarizing the current state of understanding of a topic.
VID	Video Article	An article that primarily consists of a video and a description of the content therein.
RRA	Registered report article	A Registered Report Article is a study design peer-reviewed and accepted before results are known.
RRP	Registered report protocol	A Registered Report Protocol is a peer-reviewed, preregistered study plan published before data collection.
PGL	Practice guideline	A Practice Guideline is an evidence-based recommendation document that guides clinical decision-making and best practices.
